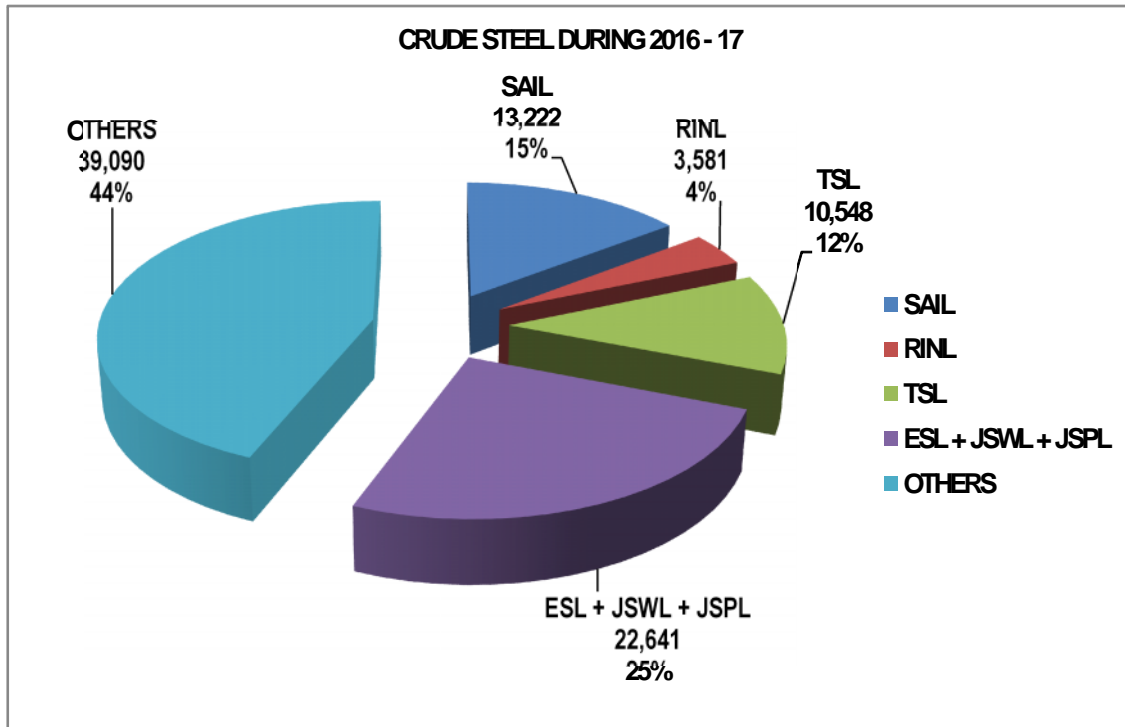

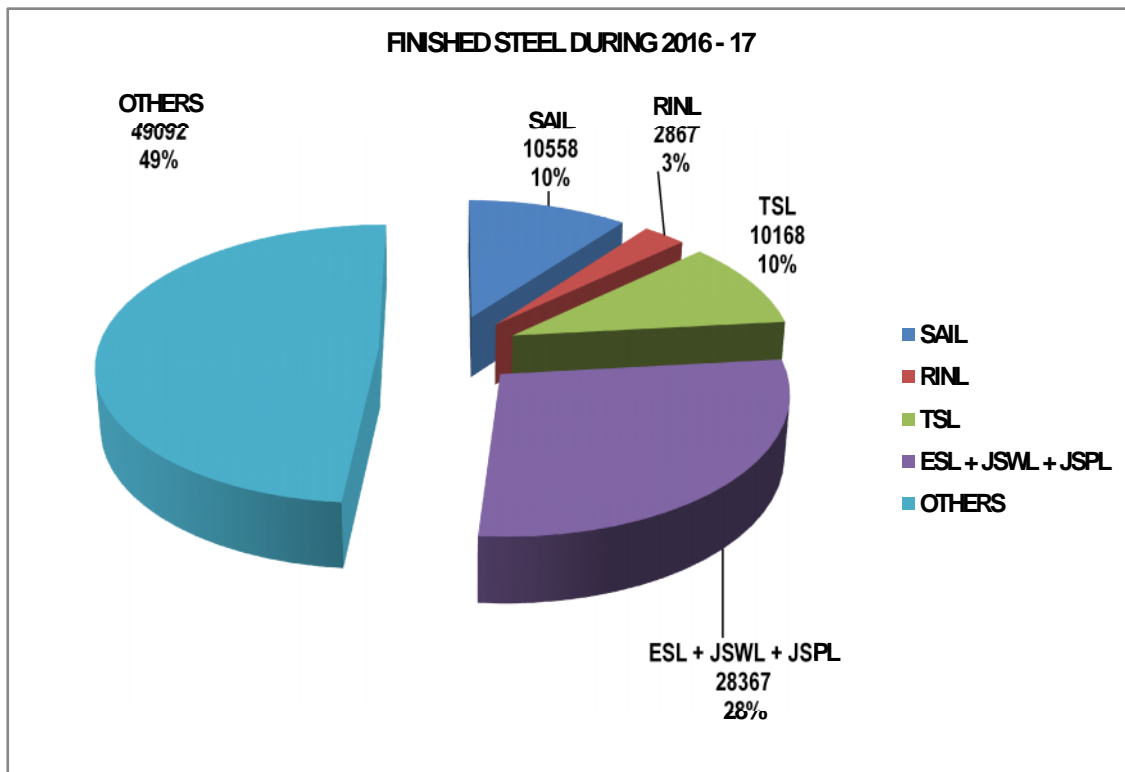
### producer - wise production of Crude Steel

## Indian Steel Industry in April-February 2016-17: A Performance Summary

The following is a status report on the performance of Indian steel industry during April-February 2016-17, based on provisional data released by JPC. It is to be noted that total finished steel includes both non-alloy and alloy (including stainless steel) and all comparisons are made with regard to same period of last year.

### I. Crude Steel:

- During April-February 2016-17, crude steel production was 89.082 million tonnes (mt), a growth of 9.3% over same period of last year.
- SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar, JSWL & JSPL together produced 49.992 mt during April-February 2016-17, which was a growth of 17% compared to same period of last year.
- The rest i.e. 39.090 mt came from the Other Producers, which was a growth of 1.2% compared to last year.
- Overall crude steel production in February 2017 (8.084 mt) was up by 8.5% over February 2016 but declined by 6.5% over January 2017.

### II. Hot Metal:

- During April-February 2016-17, hot metal production was 58.984 million tonnes (mt), a growth of 10.7% over same period of last year.
- SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar, JSWL & JSPL together produced 48.466 mt during April-February 2016-17, which was a growth of 13.3% compared to same period of last year.



- The rest i.e. 10.518 mt came from the Other Producers, which was at the same level as last year.
- Overall hot metal production in February 2017 (5.338 mt) was up by 11.5% over February 2016 but declined by 5.9% over January 2017.

### III. Pig Iron:

- During April-February 2016-17, pig iron production for sale was 8.627 million tonnes (mt), a growth of 1.6% over same period of last year.
- SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar, JSML & JSPL together produced 0.804 mt during April-February 2016-17, which was a decline of 29% compared to same period of last year.
- The rest came from the Other Producers, which was a growth of 1.7% compared to same period of last year.
- Overall pig iron production for sale in February 2017 (0.773 mt) was up by 9.6% over February 2016 but declined by 1.3% over January 2017.

### IV. Total Finished Steel:

#### A. Production for sale

- Production for sale of total finished steel at 91.846 mt, registered a growth of 11.1% during April-February 2016-17 over same period of last year.
- SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar, JSML & JSPL together produced 51.96 mt during April-February 2016-17, which was a growth of 19.2% compared to same period of last year while production for the Other Producers was down by 1.3%
- Overall finished steel production for sale in February 2017 (8.838 mt) was up by 13% over February 2016 but declined by 2.3% over January 2017.

#### B. Exports

- Export of total finished steel was up by 77.6% in April-February 2016-17 (6.622 mt) over same period of last year.
- Exports in February 2017 (0.756 mt) was up by 150% over February 2016 but declined by 15% over January 2017.



### C. Imports

- Import of total finished steel at 6.591 mt in April-February 2016-17 declined by 38.5% over same period of last year.
- Imports in February 2017 (0.491 mt) was down by 46% over February 2016 and by 19% over January 2017.
- **Given such trends in export-import, India emerged as a net exporter of total finished steel during February 2017 as well as April-February 2016-17.**

### D. Consumption

- India's consumption of total finished steel saw a growth of 3.4% in April-February 2016-17 (76.229 mt) over same period of last year.
  - Consumption in February 2017 (7.334 mt) was up by 3% over February 2016 but declined by 0.2% over January 2017.
