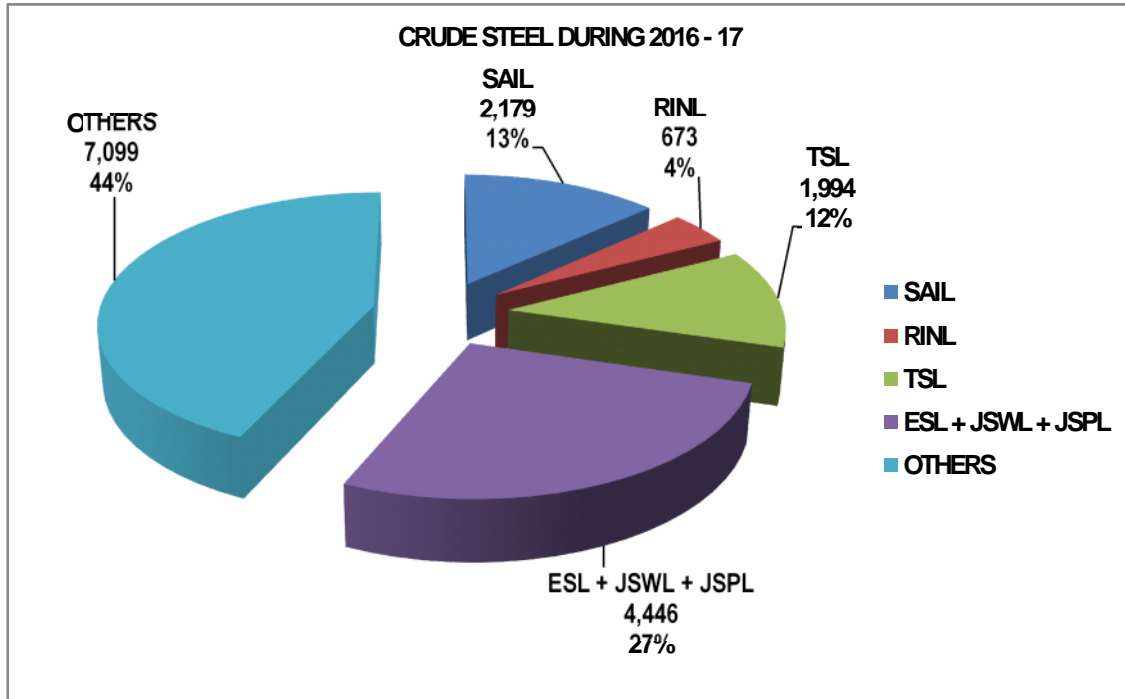

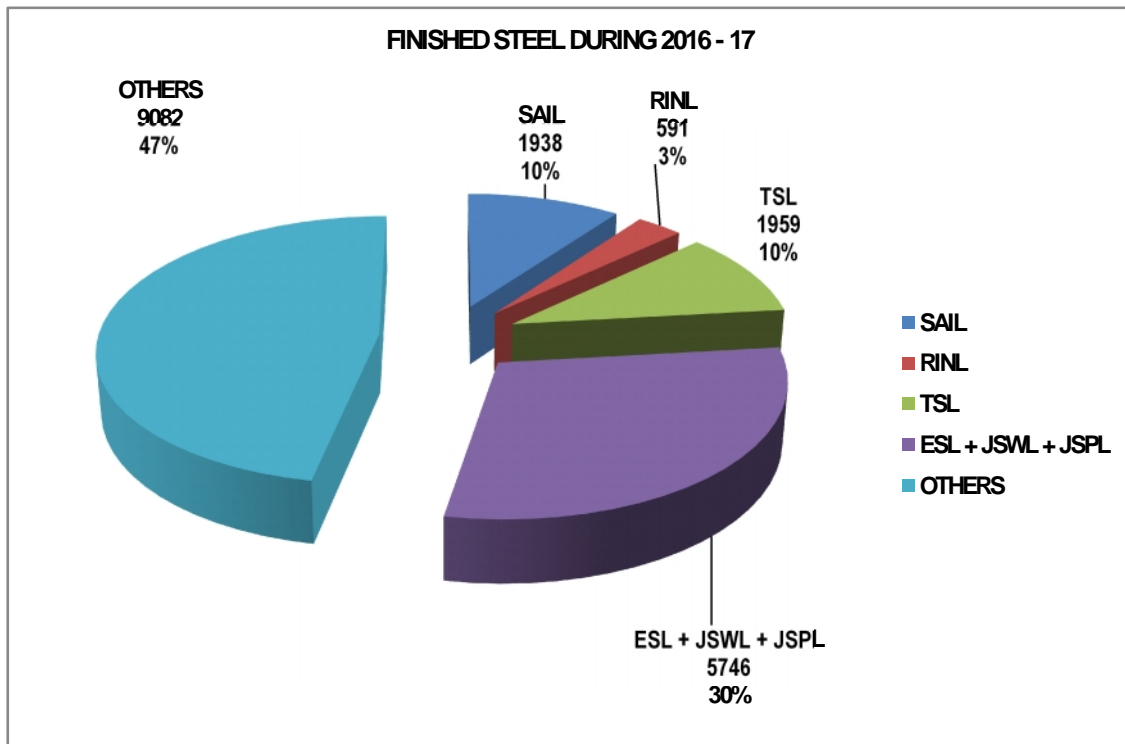
### Producer - wise Production of Crude Steel

## Indian Steel Industry in April-May 2017: A Performance Summary

The following is a status report on the performance of Indian steel industry during April-May 2017, based on provisional data released by JPC. It is to be noted that total finished steel includes both non-alloy and alloy (including stainless steel) and all comparisons are made with regard to same period of last year.

### I. Crude Steel:

- During April-May 2017, crude steel production was 16.391 million tonnes (mt), a growth of 4.5% over same period of last year.
- SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar, JSWL & JSPL together produced 9.292 mt during April-May 2017 which was a growth of 8% over same period of last year.
- The rest i.e. 7.099 mt came from the Other Producers, which was a growth of 0.4% over same period of last year.
- Overall crude steel production in May 2017 (8.163 mt) was down by 0.8% over April 2017 but was up by 2.2% over May 2016.

### II. Hot Metal:

- During April-May 2017, hot metal production was 10.607 million tonnes (mt), a growth of 2.2% over same period of last year.
- SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar, JSWL & JSPL together produced 8.679 mt during April-May 2017 which was a growth of 2.5% over same period of last year.



- The rest i.e. 1.928 mt came from the Other Producers, which was a growth of 0.9% over same period of last year.
- Overall hot metal production in May 2017 (5.303 mt) was at the same level as in May 2016 and April 2017, both.

### III. Pig Iron:

- During April-May 2017, pig iron production for sale was 1.533 million tonnes (mt), a decline of 2.5% over same period of last year.
- SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar, JSWL & JSPL together produced 94 thousand tonnes during April-May 2017 which was a decline of 39% over same period of last year.
- The rest i.e. 1.524 mt came from the Other Producers, which was a growth of 0.7% over same period of last year.
- Overall production for sale of pig iron in May 2017 (0.761 mt) was down by 1.4% over April 2017 and down by 4.8% over May 2016.

### IV. Total Finished Steel:

#### A. Production for sale

- Production for sale of total finished steel at 17.546 mt, registered a growth of 6.7% during April-May 2017 over same period of last year.
- SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar, JSWL & JSPL together produced 10.234 mt during April-May 2017 which was a growth of 15% over same period of last year.
- The rest i.e. 9.082 mt came from the Other Producers, which was a growth of 0.1% over same period of last year.
- Overall production for sale of total finished steel in May 2017 (9.066 mt) was up by 7% over April 2017 and was up by 4.4% over May 2016.

#### B. Exports

- Export of total finished steel was up by 102% in April-May 2017 (1.387 mt) over same period of last year.
- Overall exports in May 2017 (0.641 mt) was down by 14.1% over April 2017 but was up by 69% over May 2016.



### C. Imports

- Import of total finished steel at 1.062 mt in April-May 2017 declined by 11.4% over same period of last year.
- Overall imports in May 2017 (0.558 mt) was up by 10.7% over April 2017 and was up by 2.4% over May 2016.
- India was a net exporter of total finished steel in May 2017/April-May 2017.

### D. Consumption

- India's consumption of total finished steel saw a growth of 4.2% in April-May 2017 (13.785 mt) over same period of last year, under the influence of a rising production for sale.
  - Overall consumption in May 2017 (7.491 mt) was up by 19% over April 2017 and was up by 1% over May 2016.
