Indian Steel Industry in April-February 2015-16: A Performance Summary

The following is a status report on the performance of Indian steel industry during April-February 2015-16, based on provisional data released by JPC. It is to be noted that total finished steel includes both non-alloy and alloy (including stainless steel) and all comparisons are made with regard to same period of last year.

I. Crude Steel:

- During April-February 2015-16, crude steel production was 81.824 million tonnes (mt), a growth
 of 0.8% compared to same period of last year.
- The ISP Producers (SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar, JSWL & JSPL) together produced 42.893 mt during April-February 2015-16, which was a growth of 2.2% compared to same period of last year.
- The rest i.e. 38.931 mt came from the Other Producers and which was a decline of 0.7% during this period as compared to same period of last year.
- Compared to January 2016, overall crude steel production decreased by 1.2% in February 2016 (7.329 mt) led by decrease of 1.1% in case of ISP Producers and 1.3% in case of the Other Producers.
- Compared to February 2015, overall crude steel production increased by 1.8% in February 2016 led by increase of 6% in case of ISP Producers.

II. Hot Metal:

- During April-February 2015-16, hot metal production was 51.898 mt, a growth of 1.2% compared to same period of last year.
- The ISP Producers together produced 42.752 mt during April-February 2015-16, which was a
 growth of 1.8% compared to same period of last year.
- The rest i.e. 9.146 mt came from the Other Producers, which was a decline of 1.7% compared to same period of last year.
- Compared to January 2016, overall hot metal production decreased by 1.9% in February 2016 (4.599 mt) led by decrease of 2.3% in case of ISP Producers.
- Compared to February 2015, overall hot metal production decreased by 0.5% in February 2016
 led by decrease of 0.2% in case of ISP Producers and 1.9% in case of Other Producers.

III. Pig Iron:

- During April-February 2015-16, pig iron production for sale was 8.75 mt, a decrease of 1.4% compared to same period of last year.
- The ISP Producers together produced 1.006 mt during April-February 2015-16, which was a decrease of 8.5% compared to same period of last year.
- The rest was the contribution of the Other Producers, a decline of 0.9% compared to same period of last year.
- Compared to January 2016, overall pig iron production for sale decreased by 1.5% in February 2016 (0.768 mt) led by decrease of 9% in case of ISP Producers and 1.1% in case of Other Producers.
- Compared to February 2015, overall pig iron production for sale was down by 8.7% in February 2016 led by decrease of 52% in case of ISP Producers and 2.8% in case of the Other Producers.

Total Finished Steel:

A. Production for sale

- Production for sale of total finished steel at 82.883 mt, registered a decline of 1.9% during April-February 2015-16 compared to same period of last year.
- During April-February 2015-16, the ISP Producers produced 42.355 mt, which was a decrease of 0.8% compared to same period of last year while the rest was the contribution of Other Producers, down by 3.3% compared to same period of last year.

- Compared to January 2016, overall production for sale in February 2016 (7.315 mt) decreased by 6.9% led by decline in case of both the ISP Producers (by 9.1%) and the Other Producers (by 7.4%).
- Compared to February 2015, overall production for sale in February 2016 decreased by 0.9% led by decrease in case of Other Producers (by 3.4%).

B. Exports

- Export of total finished steel was down by 31.9% in April-February 2015-16 (3.456 mt) compared to same period of last year.
- Exports in February 2016 (0.299 mt) increased by 21.5% compared to January 2016 and decreased by 25.6% compared to February 2015.

C. Imports

- Import of total finished steel at 10.215 mt in April-February 2015-16 saw a growth of 20.5% compared to same period of last year.
- Imports in February 2016 (0.912 mt) decreased by 0.1% compared to January 2016 and decreased by 7.3% compared to February 2015.
- India was a net importer of total finished steel in the current fiscal so far.

D. Consumption:

- India's consumption of total finished steel saw a growth of 4.3% in April-February 2015-16 (72.752 mt) compared to same period of last year. Such growth was mostly led by imports (up by 20.5%) given that production for sale was down by 1.9% during this period.
- Domestic steel consumption in February 2016 (6.842 mt) decreased by 1.9% compared to January 2016 but increased by 4.7% compared to February 2015.
