Indian Steel Industry in April-January 2015-16: A Performance Summary

The following is a status report on the performance of Indian steel industry during April-January 2015-16, based on provisional data released by JPC. It is to be noted that total finished steel includes both non-alloy and alloy (including stainless steel) and all comparisons are made with regard to same period of last year.

I. Crude Steel:

- During April-January 2015-16, crude steel production was 74.469 million tonnes (mt), a growth of 0.7% compared to same period of last year.
- The ISP Producers (SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar, JSWL & JSPL) together produced 38.981 mt during April-January 2015-16, which was a growth of 1.7% compared to same period of last year.
- The rest i.e. 35.488 mt came from the Other Producers and which was a decline of 0.5% during this period as compared to same period of last year.
- Compared to December 2015, overall crude steel production increased by 1.5% in January 2016 (7.392 mt) led by increase of 3.5% in case of ISP Producers.
- Compared to January 2015, overall crude steel production decreased by 1.5% in January 2016 led by decrease of 1.7% in case of Other Producers while production declined by 1.4% in case of ISP Producers.

II. Hot Metal:

- During April-January 2015-16, hot metal production was 47.355 mt, a growth of 1.5% compared to same period of last year.
- The ISP Producers together produced 39.041 mt during April-January 2015-16, which was a growth of 2.2% compared to same period of last year.
- The rest i.e. 8.314 mt came from the Other Producers, which was a decline of 1.7% compared to same period of last year.
- Compared to December 2015, overall hot metal production increased by 3.3% in January 2016 (4.745 mt) led by increase of 3.7% in case of ISP Producers.
- Compared to January 2015, overall hot metal production decreased by 4.8% in January 2016 led by decrease of 5.2% in case of ISP Producers and 3% in case of Other Producers.

III. Pig Iron:

- During April-January 2015-16, pig iron production for sale was 7.981 mt, a decrease of 0.6% compared to same period of last year.
- The ISP Producers together produced 0.957 mt during April-January 2015-16, which was a decrease of 1.5% compared to same period of last year.

- The rest was the contribution of the Other Producers, a decline of 0.7% compared to same period of last year.
- Compared to December 2015, overall pig iron production for sale decrease by 1.4% in January 2016 (0.779 mt) led by decrease of 3.7% in case of ISP Producers and 0.8% in case of Other Producers.
- Compared to January 2015, overall pig iron production for sale was down by 4.9% in January 2016 led by decrease of 21.8% in case of ISP Producers and 1.7% in case of the Other Producers.

Total Finished Steel:

A. Production for sale

- Production for sale of total finished steel at 75.66 mt, registered a decline of 1.8% during April-January 2015-16 compared to same period of last year.
- During April-January 2015-16, the ISP Producers produced 38.623 mt, which was a decrease of 0.9% compared to same period of last year while the rest was the contribution of Other Producers, down by 3.3% compared to same period of last year.
- Compared to December 2015, overall production for sale in January 2016 (7.949 mt) increased by 9.1% led by growth in case of both the ISP Producers (by 13.3%) and the Other Producers (by 4.9%).
- Compared to January 2015, overall production for sale in January 2016 decreased by 1.7% led by decrease in case of Other Producers (by 3.3%).

B. Exports

- Export of total finished steel was down by 32.5% in April-January 2015-16 (3.156 mt) compared to same period of last year.
- Exports in January 2016 (0.245 mt) decreased by 37.2% compared to December 2015 and decreased by 54.1% compared to January 2015.

C. Imports

- Import of total finished steel at 9.306 mt in April-January 2015-16 saw a growth of 24.1% compared to same period of last year.
- Imports in January 2016 (0.916 mt) decreased by 2.8% compared to December 2015 and decreased by 8.7% compared to January 2015.
- India was a net importer of total finished steel in the current fiscal so far.

D. Consumption:

- India's consumption of total finished steel a growth of 4.2% in April-January 2015-16 (65.919 mt) compared to same period of last year. Such growth was mostly led by imports (up by 24.1%) given that production for sale was down by 1.8% during this period.
- Domestic steel consumption in January 2016 (6.982 mt) increased by 2.9% compared to December 2015 and by 2.8% compared to January 2015.
